2017 Kokusai Budoin, IMAF International European Seminar Plauen, Germany

Immediately after the opening ceremony, participants divided into groups for practice.

Karate-do participants gathered in the central gymnasium to begin their studies.

Higuchi Sensei lead the session with his characteristic emphasis on timing, power and combinations. Indeed, he took time to discuss Japan's ancient virtues such as diligence, humility, perseverance, and energy acquired in the process of pursuit of perfection are indispensable not only as a discipline for martial arts but also to properly develop the individual. Throughout the day, senior international instructors assisted participants to refine his or her practice.

laido practice was directed by Kumazawa Sensei with assistance by Christine Rauscher Sensei. More than 50 participants joined the weekend sessions, gaining numerous significant insights into the sublime and subtle art of drawing the Japanese sword (iaido). Participants included senior Kokusai Budoin, IMAF members, friends as well as men and women for whom this was their first international European seminar. Indeed, everyone discovered new insights, encouragement, and took additional steps along the path, or 'way' of laido.
